a) Welsh Championships 2013: Eryri has 25 SI units. Eryri will require help getting kit from other clubs

PR confirms that there should not be a problem getting kit: Adrian Moir, Graham Tough of SWOC, Steve Walsh (POW) have the expertise. PR can provide contacts from SWOC.

b) FUNDING FOR DEVELOPMENT

After the failure to get funding from SCW for a development role in Welsh Orienteering, specifically with a view to building towards each Croeso, Rose Phillips has some ideas on this: People and Places Lottery funding is open again. "Including the excluded...." She suggested one could frame it to cover the whole of Wales.

Indirectly other things: Sport Wales website does not have Orienteering. What would I like to do? No mention of orienteering.

There is funding around for small things: not developing orienteering per se but using it to develop mental health, improving fitness, access to the environment. Maybe money for an awareness marketing campaign.

Could investigate what might be there and what might be done ... and what could be done towards the next Croeso.

PR would rather someone went ahead with the investigative work than if we just discussed at endless meetings.

To go for bids you need to show that we could match funding. Volunteer time can be put against match funding... follow the projects and the spin-off anticipated would be someone working for Croeso...

Might stand a better chance if it is regional. Do we know?

Best way to progress? Rose and Gabriella to have a conversation about possibilities and GW to write a comment on report.

c) JOK wants to run their chasing start event on the Sat before the Welsh Championships in October. Officially the Welsh Champs should be just a one day event.
