As we move into Spring, it's time to get organised for bigger events! Entry dates are beginning to fly at us so here are our relevant ones:

<u>Welsh Championships</u> – Early entry deadline Sunday 3rd Feb (be quick!). To be held in Nash Woods by MWOC on Sunday 3rd March near Presteigne – see extra article for details.

Welsh League 2019 #1 – Online entry deadline Sunday 11th Feb. To be held on Mynydd-y-Garn, Brecon Beacons by SBOC on Sunday 17th Feb. (Entry on the day will be very limited so do enter in advance).

<u>The JK</u> – Cheaper entry rates until Sunday 24th Feb so get those in soon. This is one of the UK's biggest events of the year with 4 races over the Easter Weekend, 19th-22nd April, and will be held in Surrey this year.
